United Way Launches Palm Beach County Food Finder Map
Tool Will Connect Residents to Available Food Resources in the Community

West Palm Beach, Fla. (May 13, 2020) – On a typical day in Palm Beach County, more than 185,000 residents do not know where their next meal will come from. That number has dramatically increased due to the economic impacts of the coronavirus.

As the leader of the county-wide Hunger Relief Plan, United Way launched the Palm Beach County Food Finder map to streamline the community’s hunger relief efforts and quickly connect residents seeking food resources with nearby sites providing free food, hot meals, and affordable produce.
