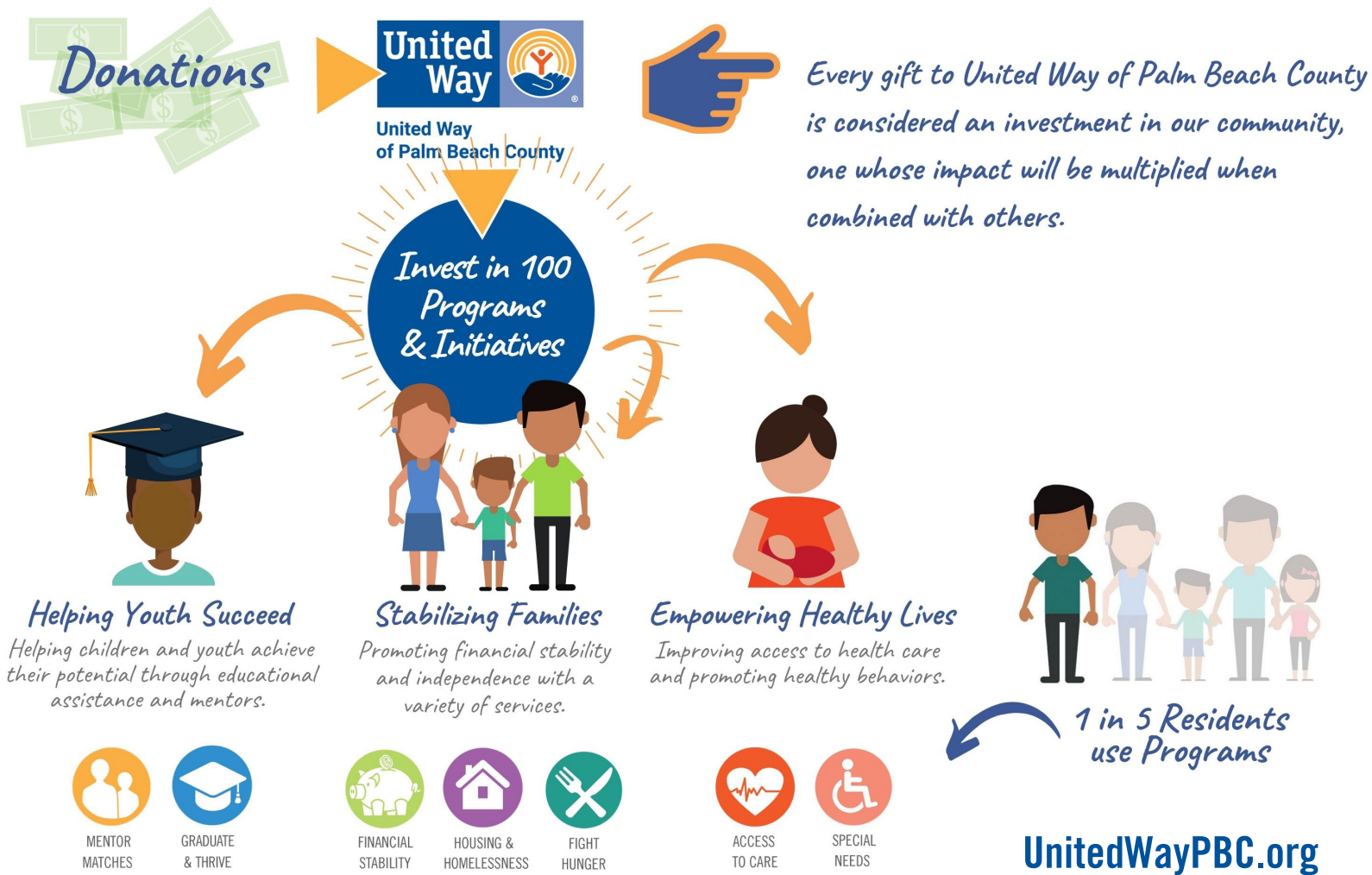

### Our Work is Focused on Three Investment Areas:

#### HELPING YOUTH SUCCEED

**GOAL:** For local youth to have access to a positive, caring relationship with a nonparental adult, and gain the education, skills and supports to succeed in life.

Funded programs facilitate quality mentoring relationships, promote academic achievement, and prepare youth for post-secondary education and employment.

#### STABILIZING FAMILIES

**GOAL:** To help local households increase their income through employment and grow their savings and assets; have access to nutritious food; and achieve housing stability.

Funded programs support employment for adults with disabilities, provide financial coaching; teach nutrition education and distribute food; and provide housing stabilization for individuals and families.

#### EMPOWERING HEALTHY LIVES

**GOAL:** To increase residents' access to health insurance and services, and enhance the quality of life for children and adults with disabilities.

Funded programs enroll residents in health care programs, promote health and wellness, and provide primary, oral, and mental health care. In addition, we fund programs that provide quality activities, respite care, and medically necessary equipment for individuals with special needs.
