SOPHIA'S story...



Sophia and her two children became homeless after her abusive husband found out she was pregnant with their third child. In spite of their circumstances, she did not miss a day of work and her children never missed a day of school.

In need of insurance coverage for her pregnancy, stable housing, and resources to live a healthy life, Sophia discovered Healthy Mothers Healthy Babies. Within a month, their Prenatal Care Coordinator found her an affordable rental apartment, provided her with a crib and furniture for the new baby, and connected them with other critical resources for stability.
